We have started again! Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday each week from 9.15-11.30am in the Church Hall.

- The Group is open to babies and toddlers up to their 3rd birthday.
- Cost of £2 per family per day.
- Coffee, tea and covered biscuits are provided for adults. Compostable paper cups are used.
- All hot drinks are served behind a safety barrier to avoid accidents.
- Parents and guardians are encouraged to bring their own snacks for their children; no raisins or nuts, please.
- There is a child-specific first aid kit available, as well as one for adults.
- As the groups develop, we hope a committee will be established with parent/guardian and volunteer members.
- Parents and guardians should return toys to the toy cupboard. They will need to be wiped down as they go away. Wipes are provided.
- Covid rules re masks and hand sanitisers still apply.

This is part of our community engagement, and it is good to be able to be back and offer support to a section of our neighbourhood where there is usually less on offer through the church. We wish to be able to open the church and share the space and create a place of hospitality. We are thus looking for a team of folk who may be able to attend once a fortnight (if we get enough volunteers) to say hello and offer some coffee. It is one of the more straightforward things we can do to simply be open and supporting to our neighbours.

Given C0VID-19 restrictions, all adults are still required to wear masks and there is ventilation. There are also some rules about serving tea and coffee but in the setting of the Parents and Toddlers Group, this is very straightforward.
