

## The Guild

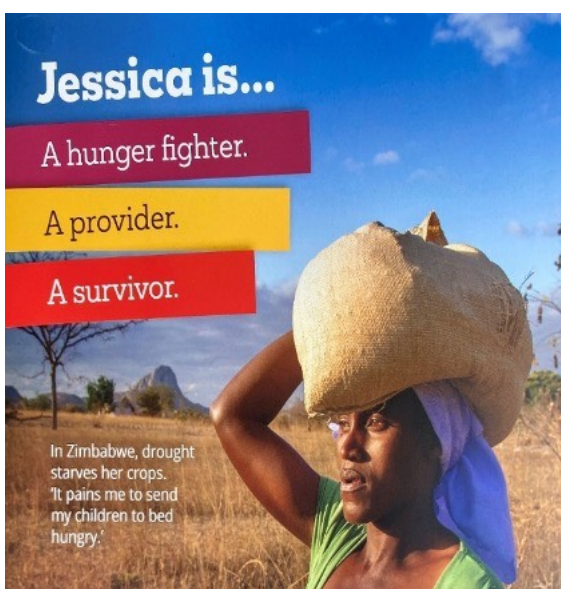
