Presbytery Mission Plan Update

A special meeting of Clyde Presbytery was held last Saturday to discuss the latest draft Mission Plan. Our Representative Elder, Fiona Nicolson, attended and voted on our behalf. Our Session Clerk also attended as appointed representative to express the views of the special Kirk Session meeting held last Wednesday to discuss the Plan. Over 4 ½ hours, Presbytery considered the proposals for each of the six clusters and agreed some small amendments to the Plan, before it was finally approved for submission to National Church. What happens now is that the Plan is considered by the Church's Faith Impact Forum and the General Trustees. If they agree the Plan, it is returned to Presbytery for a final vote before it becomes the approved plan; if they do not approve, it is returned to Presbytery for further discussion and the process repeated until approval is obtained.

If the Plan is eventually agreed in its current form, we will form a Parish Grouping with the Cross Church and Cairns Church in Milngavie, each church retaining its minister, buildings, and separate identity, but working together to encourage mission across three parishes. Eventually, there will be two ministers for the three congregations and how that will work in practice will be for us all to decide over the next five years.

Killermont and Westerton Churches will be working towards a union based at Killermont (although they may retain a presence in Westerton), and Baljaffray will be working towards a union with St Luke's in Milngavie. Baljaffray will be allowed to call a new minister to fill the vacancy created by Ian McEwan demitting the charge at the end of December, once the Plan receives final approval.

After the service on Sunday 26th March, we will have the **Stated Annual Meeting**. The Treasurer will present our accounts and any questions can be asked.
